In late October our Operations Director Roland Immler attended The World's Number 1 Trade Fair for the Plastics Industry!

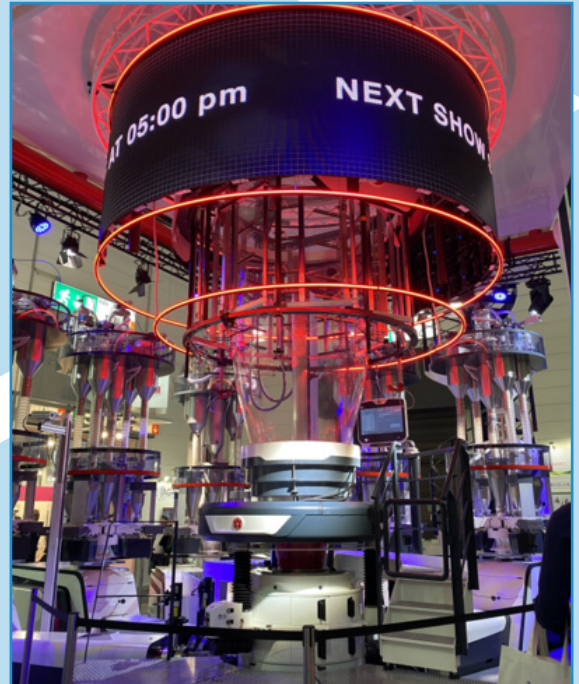
He says day one was all about recycling machines, where a variety of companies such as Genox, Erema and NGR, and others showed off their latest and greatest.

EGMONT COMMERCIAL

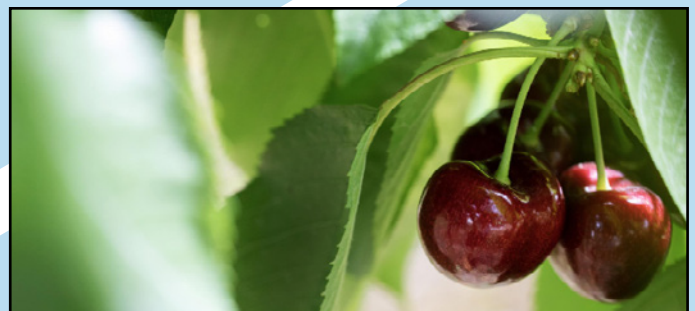
